

LESSONS

As agreed by contract, every pupil will have an individual weekly lesson. There will be 32 half hour lessons per school year. In principle YMBSA lessons will rotate during the school day. Where possible each teacher will also endeavour to accommodate the wishes of exam students and parents.

Pupils will also be given the opportunity to perform at regular intervals.

FEES

For the year 2022-2023 the monthly fee is \notin 96,00.

Payments are to be made to the teacher's account before the 9th September 2022 and by standing order on the 1st of every month from 1st October through to 1st June 2023. A total of 10 monthly payments.

Please note: where payment of fees falls in arrears, the teacher reserves the right to discontinue the lessons.

Music books and other materials purchased by the teacher will be invoiced separately.

CANCELLATION

Parents are requested to inform the teacher, a minimum of 24 hours in advance, of a pupil's absence; **including school trips.** If a student misses a lesson due to illness or for any other essential reason, the lesson will be rescheduled where possible.

N.B. Lessons missed due to extra holidays taken during term time will not be rescheduled.

If a teacher misses a lesson, they will arrange another lesson at a mutually convenient time. In the case of a teacher's absence for a longer period due to illness or another unavoidable absence, the teacher reserves the right to provide a suitably qualified and approved substitute.

TERMINATION

When a parent wishes to terminate the contract with the teacher, **one month's written notice** is required.

RESPONSIBILITY

All negotiations in respect of instrumental lessons are strictly **a private matter** between the teacher and the parent. The British School of Amsterdam is not held responsible for any problems arising on either side.

If your child has any medical conditions/learning challenges, please include this information on the agreement form.

Each child is expected to have a suitable instrument to practice on.

Pupils can enroll for a maximum of two YMBSA instruments, in consultation with their form tutor.
